- 4 **Côtes du Rhône Blanc, La Fleur Solitaire, Côtes du Rhône, 2016** £32
Complex and full of flavour with hints of hedgerow flowers and honey, this is a delicate, fresh and refined wine.
- 5 **Petit Chablis, La Chablisienne, Burgundy, 2016** £37
Fresh, clean and vibrant with notes of apple and citrus, alongside the typical dry steeliness.
- 6 **Macon Charnay Les Chenes, Domaine Manciat-Poncet, 2015** £44
Good weight and complexity with fresh green apples, grapefruit and mineral flavours. Some bread character and a clean, refreshing finish.
- 7 **Sancerre, Domaine Cherrier, Loire, 2016** £46
Subtle and refined with raw blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry flavours typical of the Sauvignon Blanc grape. A dry wine with pronounced fruit.
- 8 **Chablis, Domaine Louis Michel, Burgundy, 2016** £49
Dry, crisp and minerally with mouth-watering peach and apricot flavours.
- 9 **Pouilly Fuissé, Domaine Trouillet, Mâconnais, 2015** £59
Notes of fresh peach and grapefruit combine with toasted brioche and honey to give a rich lasting finish. This vineyard produces intense weighty wines to rival the top Burgundies.
- 10 **Montagny 1er Cru, J.M. Boillot, Burgundy, 2014** £69
Lemon peel and grapefruit notes are balanced by a creamy palate and soft oak. This esteemed wine maker has made a wine that stands up to the greats of a good Mersault.
- 11 **Puligny Montrachet, Domaine Jean Louis Chavy, Burgundy, 2016** £85
Elegant yet full bodied with flavours of citrus and honey, complemented by a touch of toasty oak and fresh acidity to balance.
- 12 **Chassagne-Montrachet, Domaine Jean-Marc Pillot, Burgundy, 2014** £95
Fresh, zesty and complex wine with good buttery fruit and integrated oak. Jean-Marc Pillot's wines seem to possess everything - richness and depth of fruit, the classic firmness of a great Chassagne and a long, smooth and harmonious finish.

- 50 **Le Havre de Paix, Aude, 2016** £17.50
This ripe and juicy blend of Syrah and Grenache is full of soft berry fruits.
- 51 **Côtes du Rhône "Terre di Mistral", Estezargues, 2016** £29
Soft in the mouth with velvety tannins and ripe red and dark fruits and hints of tobacco and leather. The Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre grapes are all selected from organic growers.
- 52 **Château de Bon Ami, Bordeaux, 2014** £29.50
Smooth and well balanced with red berries, cherry and darker fruit and a subtle smokiness.
- 53 **Fleurie, Les Florines, Jacques Charlet, Burgundy, 2016** £39
Classically light, fresh and fruity with ripe raspberry. Soft and supple with smoky and floral hints.
- 54 **Château de Roques, Puisseguin St Emilion, Bordeaux, 2014** £45
With 10 years of age, this is a mature and smooth wine. Cherry, plum and ripe dark fruit flavours soft earth and dry wood smoke lead to smooth, sweet tannins.
- 55 **Crozes Hermitage, Vidal Fleury, Northern Rhône, 2014** £64
Raspberry, blackcurrant and ripe fruits combine with pepper and spices. Well structured tannins and a stay in oak give a long pleasing finish. This well known producer makes elegant easy drinking Rhone wines.
- 56 **Château Haut Bergey, Pessac Leognan, Bordeaux, 2002** £69
A fully mature Bordeaux showing 15 years of development. This elegant wine is a blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon and shows classic notes of tobacco, cassis, dark cherry and leather.
- 57 **Savigny les Beaune, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Denis Carré, Burgundy, 2013** £75



Juicy blueberry, raspberry and sour cherry notes, balanced with soft tannins and hints of cinnamon. This classic pinot noir comes from old low-yielding vines, which produce extremely concentrated and deeply flavoured grapes, which are hand harvested.

- 13 **Oxford Dry, Bothy Vineyard, Oxfordshire, 2016** £33
This crisp local wine has a floral nose, yellow plums and greengage on the palate, crisp acidity and a long finish. Dry with lively fruit and floral notes. From only 2 miles away.
- 14 **Chardonnay, Guinevere, Gusbourne Estate, Kent, 2013** £68
Crisp, vibrant lemon citrus with intense buttery toasted vanilla notes and a distinct nutty character. 100% malolactic fermentation with 9 months in old French oak.

Red

- 58 **Pinot Noir, Gusbourne Estate, Kent, 2014** £79
Sweet oak and elegant tannins with vanilla, raspberry ripple and red cherry flavours. Decanter World Wine Award winner.

- 15 **Rioja Blanco, Rioja Vega, 2016** £24
Refreshing and dry with clean notes of flowers and fruits with hints of coconut and grapefruit.
- 16 **Cora Loxarel, Penedes, Catalonia 2017** £33
A blend of the hugely aromatic Muscat grape and the local Xarel lo grape. Fresh and silky with honeysuckle, white flowers and hints of tropical fruit and peach. Biodynamic.
- 17 **Gewürztraminer, Bodegas Pirineos, Somontano, 2016** £34
Subtle and elegant for a Gewürztraminer. Hints of jasmine, honeysuckle, ripe peaches and sweet spice on the nose. Dry and crisp, with citrus flavours and a mineral backbone.
- 18 **Albariño, Lagar de Bouza, Rias Baixas, 2016** £38
Dry and fresh with notes of lemon zest, fresh lime, stone fruits and flint and a satisfying mouth feel.

- 59 **Tempranillo Merlot Syrah, Abadia Mercier 'A', Castilla, 2016** £22
Juicy and fresh with red and black fruits, hints of smoke and spice and a long damson finish.
- 60 **Rioja, Navajas Tinto, 2016** £25
Rich and fruity, with smooth vanilla flavours.
- 61 **Rioja Reserva, Beronia, 2013** £44
Intensely aromatic, harmonious and complex, with a smooth silky finish. Aged in American and French oak for 18 months.

- 19 **Verdicchio 'Vigneto di Gino', San Lorenzo, Marche, 2017** £32
Clean, fresh green apple notes are augmented by some leesy richness which adds texture and the quintessential almond character found in all the best Verdicchio. Organic and biodynamic.
- 20 **Soave, DOC Sereole, Bertani, Veneto, 2016** £35

Bottle



Full bodied with apricot, pineapple and melon flavours. 100% Garganega, this wine is harmonious, with a soft mouthfeel and a hint of spice and oak on the finish.

- 21 **Gavi del Comune di Gavi, Alasia, Piedmont, 2016** £39.50
The Cortese grape gives a crisp and lime-scented wines typical of Gavi. Bursting with apple, peach and honeydew flavours with hints of lime and almond.

- 62 **Primitivo, Boheme, Salento, 2017** £24
Rich plum, black cherry and dried fruit flavours with spicy notes of cracked black pepper. A well balanced wine with a velvety texture.

- 63 **Chianti, Volpetto, DOCG, 2014** £28
This classic Sangiovese wine from Tuscany is well structured and full-bodied, lively and intense. It is full of fruit with a hints of spice.



- 64 **Neropasso Rosso, Mabis, Veneto, 2015** £35
Complex, rich and spicy with indulgent dried fruit, smooth tannins and a velvety mouth feel. Reminiscent of Amarone.

- 65 **Valpolicella Ripasso DOC, Bertani, Veneto, 2014** £44
Intense notes of blackcurrant, red plums, raspberry, black cherry and spice. A blend of Corvina and Rondinella. The perfect balance between acidity, sweetness and body.

- 66 **Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Poliziano, Tuscany, 2014** £64
Well structured with an intense perfume of juicy, ripe fruit and a rich palate, with just the right amount of tannin. This is Sangiovese at its very best!

- 67 **Amarone, 3cru, Veneto, 2012** £85
This classic wine from the north east of Italy oozes rich raisin and mocha notes. With a blend of Rondinellar, Corvina and Barbera grapes, this is a wonderfully full bodied wine.

- 68 **Artolas, Vidigal, Lisboa, 2016** **Bottle** £23
Medium bodied with red cherry, floral and earthy notes, elegant spiciness and a delicate finish. A blend of Castelao and Aragonez grapes.

- 22 **Tesch, Riesling, unplugged, Nahe, 2015** **Bottle** £36
Refreshing acidity and well-defined this Riesling is led by stone fruits, white peach and honeysuckle, with a mineral and chalky finish.

Biodynamic blend of Zweigelt and St Laurent grapes. Fresh aromas, pronounced sour cherry-fruit, Christmas spices, cinnamon and cloves, with soft tannins.

A nose of deep dark fruits and bitter chocolate leads to a full palate of spices and toffee. Smooth tannins and gentle acidity leads to a pleasing finish. | £36 |
| 76 | Columbia Valley, Syrah, Chateau St Michelle, Washington, 2014
Velvety texture, brimming with red and dark berry flavours. 18 months in oak barrels gives a smooth richness to this approachable, fruit-forward style. | £39 |

- 77 **Malbec, Los Haroldos Chacabuco, San Carlos, Uco Valley, Mendoza, 2017** £26
Smoky tannins support notes of raspberry, plum and blackcurrant alongside wood and spice.
- 78 **Malbec/Cabernet Sauvignon, Amancaya Gran Reserve, Mendoza, 2015** £52
This wine is a blend from Nicolas Catena and Baron Rothschild, two greats in the wine world. Ripe red fruits with hints of smoke and tobacco. Fine tannins give this wine an elegant velvety mouth feel.
