Classic Zweigelt, reminiscent of a Beaujolais wine. Light in style with plenty of gentle red and black fruits and a subtle spice quality. Can be serve lightly chilled. | £35 |

- 18 **Voskehat, Koor, Highland Cellars, 2015** £39
Fresh with hints of tropical fruit and subtle mineral notes. Voskehat is known as the queen of Armenian grape varieties, literally meaning 'Golden Seed' and has a diverse and very rich aromatic bouquet. The signature and subtle mineral notes come from the unique soil of the region which is a combination of volcanic sediment and limestone.

New Zealand

- 24 **Sauvignon Blanc, Southern Dawn, Marlborough, 2018** £32
Complex blackcurrant leaf, grapefruit and tropical fruit flavours, with a lengthy citrus finish.

Red

- 70 **Pinot Noir, Yealands, Marlborough, 2017** £42
A full-bodied Pinot Noir with richness and texture, with black cherry, plum and violets and hints of savoury spice. The finish is long and firm.

Australia

- 25 **Elizabeth Aged Semillon, Mt Pleasant, New South Wales 2007** £43
Lively and fresh with rich lemon, lime and grapefruit notes enhanced by a refreshing acidity and a long lingering finish.

Red

- 72 **Cabernet/Shiraz, Fox Grove, South East, 2017** £26
Soft and juicy with brambly fruit, spice and blackcurrants. The palate is round and soft and has a good finish.

South Africa

White

- 26 **Chenin Blanc "Bush Vine", Good Hope, Stellenbosch, 2017** £24
Easy drinking, fruity and fresh with green apples and white peach. Certified sustainable.
- 27 **Chardonnay, MAN Family Wines, Western Cape, 2018** £26
Melon, tropical and citrus fruits and a hint of butterscotch and oak.

Red

- 73 **Pinotage, Franschoek Cellar, Stone Bridge, Western Cape, 2016** £27
Soft and luscious with strawberry, red cherry and vanilla flavours and a touch of earthy spice.
- 74 **Lourens River Valley, Morgenster, Western Cape, 2003** £49
This blend of Merlot and Cabernet Franc starts with notes of lavender, thyme and hints of coffee. Then comes cassis, raspberry and rose. Full and elegant with a balance of fruit, wood and acidity.

America

- 75 **Old Vine Zinfandel, Scotto, Lodi, California, 2014** £36
A nose of deep dark fruits and bitter chocolate leads to a full palate of spices and toffee. Smooth tannins and gentle acidity leads to a pleasing finish.
- 76 **Columbia Valley, Syrah, Chateau St Michelle, Washington, 2014** £39
Velvety texture, brimming with red and dark berry flavours. 18 months in oak barrels gives a smooth richness to this approachable, fruit-forward style.

Argentina

- 77 **Malbec, Los Haroldos Chacabuco, San Carlos, Uco Valley, Mendoza, 2018** £27
Smoky tannins support notes of raspberry, plum and blackcurrant alongside wood and spice.
- 78 **Malbec/Cabernet Sauvignon, Amancaya Gran Reserve, Mendoza, 2015** £52
This wine is a blend from Nicolas Catena and Baron Rothschild, two greats in the wine world. Ripe red fruits with hints of smoke and tobacco. Fine tannins give this wine an elegant velvety mouth feel.

- 71 **Cabernet Sauvignon, Long Country, Central Valley, 2017** £25
Soft black and juicy red fruits with smooth tannins. Rounded, mellow and well balanced.
